

## WHITEWATER SERIES: Special Tiedown Placements

Shown are some of the most common placements\* of extra tiedowns on the Whitewater series boats (Gnarwhal & Alpackalypse). Please use these descriptions in the 'Customer Notes' field at check out and add the appropriate number of installed grab loops and/or strap plates to your order:



- A. Long Case** – two (2) strap plates attached to the outside of the tube approximately mid-way between waterline & deck line. Commonly used for attaching skis, or flyrod tubes to the outside of the boat.\*\*
- B. Whitewater Rail** – when ordered on a whitewater series boat we add four (4) additional grab loops to the stern of the boat allowing you to create a 'rail' at the stern for a swimmer to grab on either side of the boat.
- C. Bike Tiedowns** – we attach two (2) strap plates to the bow of your boat, and two (2) grab loops just aft of the bow to give extra attachment points for tying down your bike frame & wheels.\*\*

\*Tiedown placements shown are approximate. We're not graphic design wizards! It's tricky to show the placement exactly on a 2D diagram. Also – they will be black tiedowns and match the rest of the tiedowns on your boat. The orange is just to make them easy to identify.

\*\*Note that every item you attach to the outside of your boat becomes a potential swim hazard. Consider carefully the type of water you are paddling and your own paddling ability before making the choice to attach items to the outside of your boat.
